## **DISCUSSION**

Since 2011, City staff and Patrol Task Force have worked together to implement the Safe and Clean program which addresses debris and undesirable behavior in the downtown area. Council provided direction in 2017 to staff to address debris and behavior throughout the City.


Staff will be providing an update to City Council on current actions and will discuss efforts to further improve and enhance the City's commitment to the Safe and Clean program.


