


**DIRECTIVE OF THE DIRECTOR OF DISASTER SERVICES
DIRECTING THE CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA POLICE
DEPARTMENT AND CODE ENFORCEMENT DIVISION TO
ENFORCE THE ORDER OF THE VENTURA COUNTY HEALTH
OFFICER CLOSING BEACHES IN VENTURA COUNTY**

Pursuant to Section 2.370.050 of the San Buenaventura Municipal Code, the City Manager, acting as Director of Disaster Services, has the authority to ensure the enforcement of any order issued by the Ventura County Health Officer by issuing a directive to the City of San Buenaventura's Code Enforcement Division and the Ventura Police Department to enforce such order.

On June 30, 2020, the Ventura County Health Officer announced the closure of beaches in Ventura County for the duration of the 4th of July weekend.

Effective immediately, the Ventura Police Department and the City's Code Enforcement Division are hereby directed to enforce any order issued by the Ventura County Health Officer that closes the beaches in Ventura County for the 4th of July weekend, utilizing the enforcement procedures proscribed by Section 2.370.055 of the San Buenaventura Municipal Code.
