If by 5:00 p.m. on August 7, 2020, no one or only one person has been nominated for any office which is elected on a citywide basis, the City Clerk shall notify the council of such facts and that it may, at a regular or special meeting held before the election, adopt one of the following courses of action: 1) appoint to the office the person who has been nominated; 2) appoint to the office any eligible elector if no one has been nominated; or 3) hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

The In-Person Voting Locations will be open between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 31, Sunday, November 1, and Monday, November 2, 2020. The In-Person Voting Locations will be open 7:00 am to 8:00 pm on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

The ballots of the precincts of said cities shall be counted at a Central Counting Place, Office of the County Clerk, Elections Division, Administration Building, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, California, and any other extensions thereof as determined by the County Clerk and shall be open to the public.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified voters in the County of Ventura, State of California that the random selection of precincts to be verified for the one percent manual tally of the votes cast for the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election will be held on November 5, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. The random selection of precincts will be held in the County of Ventura Elections Division, Hall of Administration, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, and is open to the public. The manual tally process will begin on November 9, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. and will be held in the County of Ventura Elections Division, Hall of Administration, 800 South Victoria Avenue, Ventura, and is open to the public.
