For an added challenge and some extra family fun, can you find answers to all of the questions below?

- Kellogg Park has several Catalina Ironwood Trees. These are evergreen trees that can grow up to 45 feet tall. *How many of these trees can you find, and what color flower do they have?*
- Kellogg Park has a bioswale, which is a type of drain that is designed to reduce flooding and pollution from the Ventura River. This is also a great way to get free-flowing water to plants throughout the park. *How many different types of plants can you count along the edge of the bioswale?*
- Kellogg Park is home to one of Ventura's Community Gardens. *How many crops can you identify in the Community Garden? Can you think of any other crops that you could grow in your own garden?*
- Did you notice the climbing wall near the playground? *How fast can you get from the bottom to the top of the wall? OR, for more of a challenge, can you get from the bottom to the top using only one colored rock?*
- In the playground there is a rainbow pinwheel. *How many different colors are on this pinwheel? Can you find an object in the park for each color on the pinwheel?*
- A mosaic is an art piece made by putting different things together and forming a picture. There are four of them at Kellogg Park. *What shapes and objects can you see in the rock mosaics?*
- The amphitheater is an area with stone seats surrounding a stage where people can lead classes or perform a show. *What talents can you share on this stage?*
- Chess is one of the world's oldest board games. It is played on a board with black and white squares. *How many chess boards are found at Kellogg Park? Are there more black or white squares on the chess board?*
- Cornhole is another fun game that can be played at Kellogg Park. Usually the goal is to throw bean bags into the hole of one board while standing behind the other board. *Can you throw a small ball or bean bag through the hole in the board three times in a row?*
- What three streets is Kellogg Park located on?
