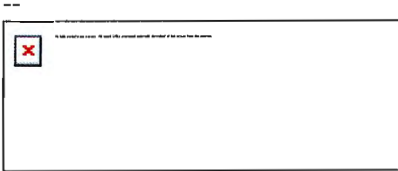

My name is Lynn Mikelachucktos. I am the owner of The Greek and Margarita Villa in Ventura Harbor. We opened The Greek in 1994 and Margarita Villa in 2003. Therefore I have seen a lot of commissioners come and go through the years. I have attended most of the commissioner interviews for the last 25 years. One thing I can say, is that the City Council for the most part does listen to the longtime and short time tenants to get a feel for what skills are truly needed at each time appointments come around. This year those skills needed are **financial** and **legal**. **Robert Bravo** is the CPA for the County of Ventura Executive offices working with Mike Powers. He has 12 years of experience as a Port Commissioner, May 2003 until April 2015. During his tenure, Robert implemented a number of financial procedures that improved accountability. He set up audits and check points for tenants to fulfil. He is an expert at creating budgets and analysis. **Jackie Gardina** is the dean of the Ventura and Santa Barbara Schools of Law and has brought a fresh perspective and legal insight to the Board. She is very willing to listen to any concerns brought forth by tenants. Jackie has just completed a two year remaining term which was vacated by Jim Friedman when he was elected to City Council two years ago. Two years is not enough time for Jackie to fully engage in improving the Port Business. I hope she is reappointed to make some needed changes on the legal realm of the District.
