

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-011

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA, CALIFORNIA, RECONFIRMING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY AND EXTENDING IT UNTIL MAY 11, 2021

WHEREAS, On March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California proclaimed a state of emergency to exist in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19, which has been declared a world-wide pandemic by the World Health Organization; and,

WHEREAS, On March 12, 2020, the County of Ventura declared a state of emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, Conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the City have arisen and continue, caused by the spreading of COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, On March 15, 2020, as a result of these conditions, the City Manager, acting as the Director of Disaster Services under Chapter 2.370 of the San Buenaventura Municipal Code, proclaimed the existence of a local emergency during a time when the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura was not in session and could not immediately be called into session; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council ratified the City Manager's proclamation at a special meeting on March 17, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, On April 27, 2020, the City Council reconfirmed the existence of a local emergency and extended it until July 15, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, On June 15, 2020, the City Council reconfirmed the existence of a local emergency and extended it until September 13, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, On September 8, 2020, the City Council reconfirmed the existence of a local emergency and extended it until November 12, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, On November 9, 2020, the City Council reconfirmed the existence of a local emergency and extended it until January 11, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, On January 11, 2021, the City Council reconfirmed the existence of a local emergency and extended it until March 12, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8630 requires that the existence of a local emergency be reconfirmed at least every sixty days, or the existence of a local emergency will terminate; and,


WHEREAS, Unless otherwise extended, the local emergency will terminate on March 12, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura does hereby resolve, find, determine, and order as follows:

Section 1: That a state of local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist and is hereby reconfirmed as of March 8, 2021 and extended for an additional 60 days until May 11, 2021, unless terminated by action of the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura, State of California.


Section 2: That the City Clerk shall cause this state of local emergency to be scheduled for reconfirmation at least every 60 days until terminated by this City Council.


