In the letter dated October 6, 2021 from Gregory G. Diaz, City Attorney to Honorable Mayor and City Council, subject "Consideration of A Resolution of the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura, California, Reconfirming the Existence of a Local Emergency and Extending it Until January 7, 2022" it was stated that "The conditions that justified the proclamation of the local emergency continue to exist."

No evidence was presented to demonstrate that the local emergency still exists. I request that the City Council not vote on this resolution until sufficient evidence has been presented to determine if a local emergency still exists. At a minimum, evidence would include Ventura city statistics for hospitalizations and deaths from COVID during September and October 2021: 1) separating vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals; 2) identifying additional medical conditions individuals may have had.

October 19, 2021 2:14 PM from Kyler Carlson to host (privately): My name is Kyler Carlson, I'm a Resident of the City of Ventura and a renter deeply concerned by the rising cost of housing in this city. Within the next two months, Council will have the opportunity (and is required by state law) to adopt a New Housing Element. As a part of General Plan, this document is a commitment that council is making to us residents to prioritize the Housing issues that we are facing.

This New Housing Element will include about 30 existing and new programs that will help the average Venturan find and stay in their housing. As Councilmembers responsible for guiding the yearly budget process, I'd like to encourage you and staff to fully consider these programs and appropriately fund the city departments responsible for carrying out these programs.
