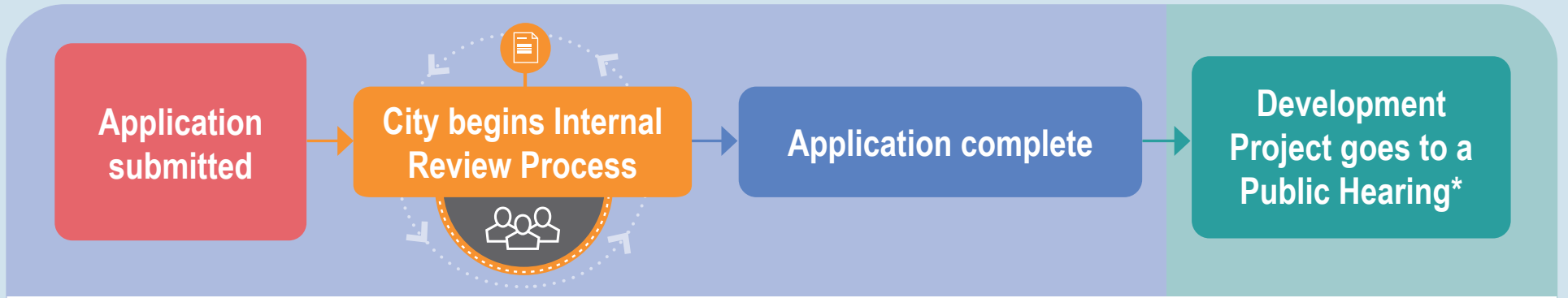

Get Involved Early



View online the Community Development Map for real-time information about projects. The map features project details, drawings, current stage of the project, and contact information for the dedicated City Planner.



Contact the City Planner listed on the development map. Planners serve as the manager on a development project for both the applicant and public.



Things you can ask the City Planner: Questions about the project, request to look at the plans and drawings, share comments and feedback on a project, or ask to stay updated on a project's progress.

Submit a written comment about a project in advance of a Public Hearing



Share feedback during a Public Hearing

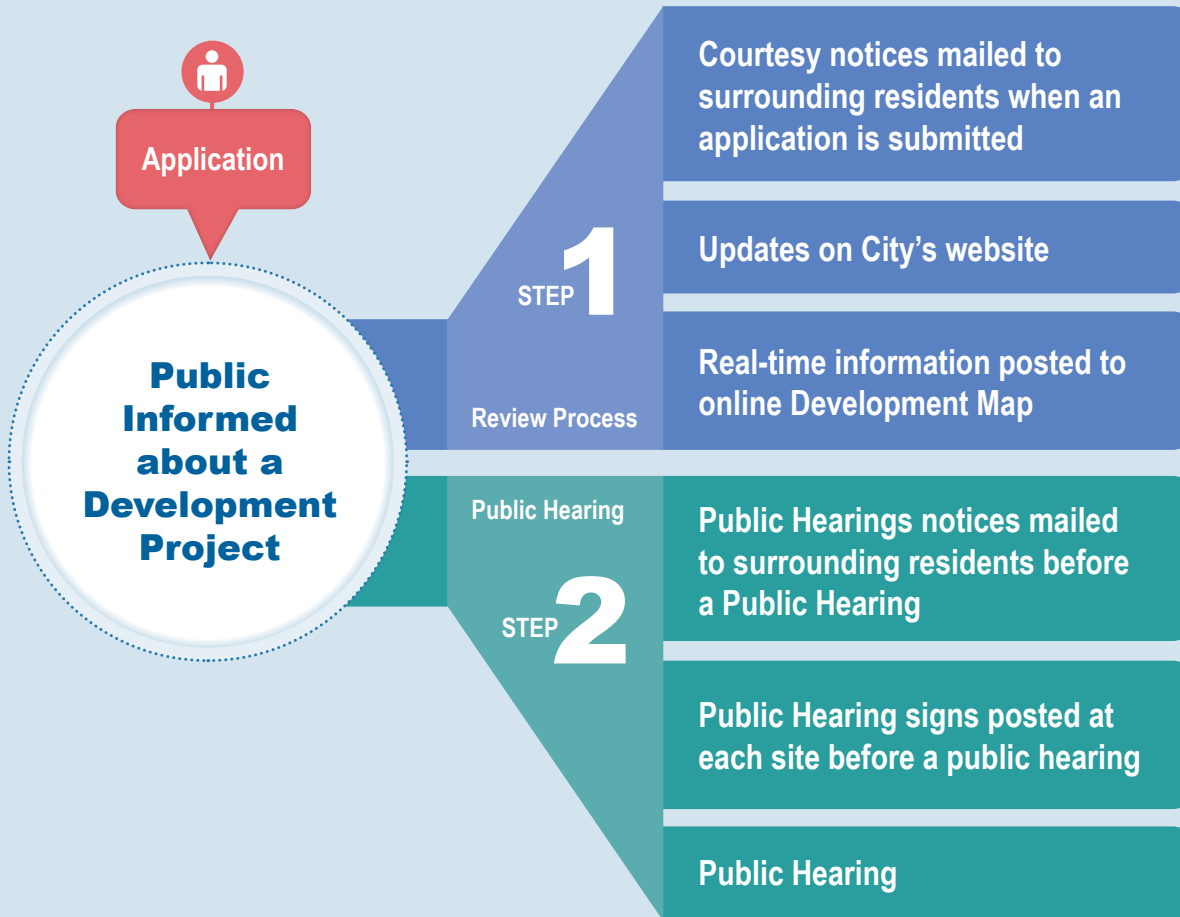

Ways the City keeps the Public Informed when a development project is submitted



Anytime an application is submitted to the City, Community Development must process the application.
