 Amendment to the 2019-2020 CDBG Action Plan
 May 2022 Summary

The City of San Buenaventura (Ventura or City) is a federal entitlement community that receives annual allocations of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The City is required to prepare an Annual Action Plan detailing the uses of entitlement funds to meet its affordable housing and community development goals as outlined in its Consolidated Plan. For program year 2019-2020, the City is proposing to make a substantial amendment to its submitted plan. The purpose of the substantial amendment is to re-allocate \$106,000 of CDBG-CV funds, which the City received as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

The proposed reallocated funds will be used by the City and its subrecipients for activities that will assist in preventing, preparing for, and responding to Coronavirus, as shown in the chart below.
