FOR TENANTS

The City of Ventura and E.J. Harrison & Sons now offer the **Organics Recycling Program** as a resource to residents to reduce organic waste in landfills and assist in compliance with new state regulations, Senate Bill (SB) 1383. Residents at multi-family properties will see a new food waste recycling container at their property.

HOW DO I USE THE NEW PROGRAM?

1



COLLECT IT

- Keep your pail handy for food prep trimmings and plate scrapings.
- Place food waste in a paper or plastic bag and secure it tightly.

KEEP IT CLEAN

- Remove stickers, twist ties, and rubber bands.
- No plastic, glass, or metal (except for the plastic bag containing the food waste).

STORE IT

- On the counter.
- Under the sink.
- In the fridge or freezer – especially for meat and fish or during hot weather.

PLACE IT IN THE RIGHT CART

- Toss your bag of food waste in the food waste recycling cart each week for pickup.

What DOES and DOES NOT go in the food waste recycling container?



ACCEPTED

All Food Waste Including

- Dairy & Eggs
- Bones & Shells
- Pasta & Grains
- Coffee Grounds
- Meat, Poultry & Seafood
- Fruits & Vegetables



NOT ACCEPTED

- Utensils
- Glass
- Napkins
- Tin & Metal
- Oil, Grease & Liquids
- Compostable Items
- Plastics (except for plastic bags containing food waste)
