

RESOLUTION NO. 2003 –029

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE SAN BUENAVENTURAMUNICIPALCODE (SBMC) – CHAPTER 6.150, ESTABLISHING A FARE SCHEDULE FOR TAXICABS OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY OF SAN BUENAVENTURA

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Buenaventura as follows:

SECTION 1: Resolution No. 2000-23, adopted by the City Council on May 1, 2000, establishing a fare schedule for taxicabs operating within the City of San Buenaventura is hereby rescinded.


SECTION 2: Persons licensed to operate and/or drive taxicabs pursuant to the provisions of SBMC Chapter 6.150 will charge the rates set forth in this Resolution.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to SBMC § 6.150.400, the City Council adopts the following rates for carrying any number of passengers up to, but not to exceed, five (5) persons in taxicabs:


- A. Distance traveled. Carriers will charge the following rates for distance traveled:
  - 1. \$2.25 per mile:
  - 2. A minimum of \$2.25 per ride (flag drop)
- B. Waiting time. Carriers may charge \$25.00 per hour for waiting time, as defined by SBMC § 6.150.020.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption,


